



## SUPPLY LIST for Whimsical Paintings In Oil or Acrylic with Cindy Revell

Please feel free to **use the pigments you are most familiar with** and that will work with the subject matter of your choice. For example if you love pink and purple flowers or turquoise and lime green elephants you will need paints that will make those colours. See my **basic and optional pigments** below, they show the pigments I use most and which ones I add to my palette if the subject matter calls for it.

- **My basic limited palette:** Cadmium Yellow or Cad Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson Permanent, Quinacridone Rose or Permanent Rose (for pure pinks and purples), Ultramarine Blue, Pthalo Blue (for turquoise), Titanium white. I can create nearly any colour using this palette. I use M. Graham because of this brand's luscious paint consistency which is juicy enough to use without medium.
- **Optional colours I add depending on the subject matter:** Lemon Yellow, dioxazine purple or magenta.
- **Brushes:** decent quality hog bristle flats (I use Robert Simmons or the blue H. J.'s which are available at Delta). Sizes 12, 10, 8, and 5 and 3 brushes would be best.
- **Canvases:** Two canvases, your preference of size, however canvases of at least 20 x 20 or so gives you room to be a bit more expressive with the brush. 30x30 is probably as big as you want to work at a workshop.
- **Miscellaneous:** sketchbook, pencil, eraser, palette of your choice, thinner (Eco House or Gamsol are good for oils), rags or paper towel, palette knife for mixing paint (not necessary but handy, I use one for mixing large quantities of paint if working on a large canvas). The venue will provide easels but if you have one you like to use feel free to bring it.
- **NOTE:** I teach **oils** but if you are an acrylic painter bring the appropriate palette, water and acrylic extender or any acrylic medium you are used to working with.
